<sup>2</sup> A referral-based inspection is an inspection initiated by Cal/OSHA staff in response to information about a potentially hazardous condition received from a non-governmental organizational entity not related to an employee at the worksite, or received from within Cal/OSHA.

<sup>3</sup> An unprogrammed-related inspection is an inspection of an employer performing work at a worksite in which another employer is being inspected by Cal/OSHA because of a complaint, accident, or referral.

<sup>4</sup> Formal complaints include those filed by a current employee or a current employee's representative.
